

PUBLIC HEARING, TOWN BOARD, TOWN OF LITTLE FALLS, JANUARY 9, 2024-
LOCAL LAW #1-2024, SOLAR FARM MORATORIUM

A Public Hearing of the Town Board, Town of Little Falls was held on January 9, 2024 at the town hall commencing at 7:04 p.m. with the following members present:

-Notice of the hearing was published in the Times Telegram Newspaper on December 20, 2023.

-Supervisor Casler called the hearing to order stating that the purpose of the hearing was to consider adoption of a six-month moratorium on solar energy farms.

-Clerk Regan stated that she found out today from the New York State Department of State, that although the Local Law was numbered as 2023-3, being that it will be filed with the state in 2024, it has to be numbered 2024-1. That for the purpose of filing a local law with the Department of State, you have to number each law consecutively, beginning with the number one for the first local law filed in each calendar year, that the next number in sequence should be applied to each local law when it is submitted for filing, regardless of its date of introduction or adoption and that the date of filing of a local law is the date on which the local law is placed on file by the state.

Attorney Macri stated that being the body of the law is the same which was advertised and presented to the public, and being the only thing different is the number, changes nothing to the law except the number.

-Supervisor Casler asked if there were any comments for against said law. There were no comments.

-All persons desiring to be heard, having been heard, the hearing was closed at 7:09 p.m.
